

The Farley Moody Galbraith Endowed Scholarship

The Department of Art and Art History announces a call to ART and ARH majors to apply for *The Farley Moody Galbraith Endowed Scholarship*.

Mrs. Galbraith established this specialized scholarship to support talented students of the department who can demonstrate financial or personal need. It is important to the Galbraith family that this scholarship be awarded to students who have faced hardships in either their personal lives or may be unable to attend college without such support.

Awards may range from \$2000-5000. The recipient of the scholarship may be eligible for scholarship renewal if they remain in good standing. Applications should include means of determining talent and ability along with written demonstration of need.

To apply: Create one PDF document that includes the following:

#1 - Personal information

- Applicant name
- CWID
- Crimson email address
- Declared major and expected graduation
- One faculty / instructor name from the department who is willing to serve as a reference

#2 - Essay

A 500 word essay that details any financial or personal needs.

Please include how a scholarship award will benefit applicant who is facing special financial circumstances.

#3 Creative work

5 – 7 images of current work OR writing samples produced in departmental classes.
